What sort of hours will I work?

The role of café assistant is for part time, 21 to 28 hours dependant on the role. We operate between 8.30am and 5.30pm so you must be flexible, a typical working day is up to 8 hours. We will sometimes have to increase these hours or days during busier times like Christmas, Easter and bank holiday weekends with extra commitment during non-term time months/ weeks. Rotas will be given with a minimum of 2 weeks' notice.
